Comments: While conducting the follow-up inspection, the inspector audited ten child files. The ten child files had the name, address and telephone number of two emergency contacts. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: Two of the 10 audited child file, the parent did not indicate that they have read and understood the parent handbook. The operator must ensure that all child files are up to date and all the requirements are met.			
44 An operator of a licensed facility shall have a first aid kit that is equipped with the contents prescribed by New Brunswick Regulation 2004-130 under the Occupational Health and Safety Act as a first aid kit that is not a personal, Type P first aid kit, and a telephone in working order (c) on each outing.	44(c)	Dec 12, 2022	May 08, 2023
