<p>Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility at 2:25 pm on November 29th, 2021 to conduct a follow-up inspection visit.</p> <p>Indoor play materials were replenished in both classrooms since the initial licensing inspection visit.</p> <p>The children in the JD Irving children room arrived at the licensed facility, washed up and had their snack. When the children finished their snack they engaged in free play activities (drawing with markers on paper, a tent was set up for the children)</p> <p>The children in the RBC room children were engaging in free play activities (UNO, "general store" and stencils and paper) when licensing staff observed them during the follow-up inspection visit. The children had art posted and priced for their classroom art auction! After free play activities, the children are going to have story time and then go outside for outdoor play time.</p> <p>Both classroom educators put Christmas music on for the children to listen to.</p> <p>All staff files have been updated and are complete with the required documents.</p>
