General Comments
<p>The JD Irving Room was creating puff paint in the afternoon with glue and shaving cream. Children used food dye to color the paint and make different creations. Other materials were in the room to offer various choices- mini sticks, puzzles, coloring sheets and word searches and a Lego table.</p> <p>The week has a different theme for each day. The planned programming showed nature, science, movement and music activities for the week.</p> <p>The RBC Room went outdoors to play and while the children did enjoy climbing the hill, they had no materials to play with. The educator shared that earlier in the day they used crazy carpets for sliding but I observed no resources or toys offered to the children in the afternoon. Please ensure educators are bringing materials outside each time for the children. Suggestions are shovels, buckets, balls, and sleds for the winter.</p> <p>All child guidance observed was positive. Educators spoke to the children in a respectful manner and took interest in what the children were saying and doing.</p>

General Comments

Fire drills have not been documented for January and February. Please remember to do a fire drill for each month and record it on the sheet.

As a reminder, the most recent monitoring inspection reports must be posted on the board.

The entrance way to the JD Irving room had some jackets, boots, and snowpants on the floor. Please have educators work with children to make sure their materials are organized on their individual hooks and to keep the entrance way and path clear.

One educator is missing a current first-aid certificate. Please register them for a first-aid course and a reminder that they cannot be alone with the children before completing the course.
