General Comments

The Inspector and the Quality Assurance Monitor arrived at the facility while children were having lunch and remained present during the transition to nap time and during nap time.

The Inspector and the Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children building with cube blocks and the staff members reading books with the children. The Inspector and the Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the children who no longer nap participating in quiet activities during relaxation time.

The Inspector and the Quality Assurance Monitor verified these items:

- Ratio and maximum number of children
- Staff files
- Indoor play area
- Child guidance
- Daily activities
- Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility

During the inspection, the child-to-staff ratio in each classroom was respected. Each staff member was fulfilling their assigned duties.

All staff files were reviewed and verified. Each staff file contains a copy of their verifications and required documents. All staff files also include a copy of their training and qualifications.

Each classroom had cleaning supplies. Each classroom had a variety of materials in sufficient quantities for all children present.

Each classroom displayed a monthly calendar of daily activities. Following recent professional learning hours, some classrooms are transitioning to purposeful planning based on children's interests. The Inspector engages in discussions with staff members who are transitioning to purposeful planning and recommends that completed activities be displayed and shared with parents.

General Comments

The inspector had a discussion with the operator regarding multiple extension cords that were stored in a high area in one classroom. The inspector recommended cleaning the extension cords and storing them in a designated storage area.

The inspector also had a discussion with the operator regarding the music played during rest time. The inspector recommends avoiding radio stations and suggested the use of calming music instead.

The Inspector and the Quality Assurance Monitor left the facility while the children were sleeping.
