<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Completed renewal inspection today. Due to COVID-19 and restrictions on group size, facility currently has 3 groupings.</p> <p>The children engaged in hand washing upon arrival to program. Educators value the children by providing choice in daily activities (ex: upon arrival to the program today, the children were asked whether they wanted to play indoors or outdoors first).</p> <p>Indoors, children were engaged in mark making, creative art activities, sensory play (water play), constructing air planes and playing board games. Documentation of the children's learning was displayed within the environment in the form of photographs, art work, murals and diagrams.</p> <p>Epipens and medications that may be needed in an emergency should not be locked, but kept inaccessible to children. The children are reportedly spending lots of time outdoors. Today the children were engaged exploring the wooded area, and painting on the pavement with spray chalk paint.</p> <p>Discussed group logs with staff during time of inspection. Group logs are being completed daily as required.</p>
