<p>General Comments</p> <p>A Monitoring Inspection occurred this afternoon May 2, 2024.</p> <p>Upon arrival the K-2 age group of school age children were observed during free play. Educators stated that the children are presently very interested in arts and building racetracks and dressing in costumes for imaginary play. Educators were observed using positive language and giving gentle reminders.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent place is available to post the license, current inspection report, current monitoring reports, orders for compliance. All required records and documents are maintained for a year. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and posted.</p> <p>The indoor space is set up and inviting, the materials that were set up invite the children to play. Well defined learning / play areas were observed, and several pieces of the children's artwork were displayed throughout the facility. Ideas from the web/learning story are reflected in the art area/library/building area/dramatic play areas. Books have been selected that reflect the children's interests. Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility. Educators provide opportunities for curriculum to be extended outdoors and efforts are made to bring the natural world into the classroom. Webs have been completed with the children and have been expanded upon with educators.</p> <p>Open-ended questions are asked by educators and actively listening to answers, using paraphrasing to ensure they heard correctly. Positive child guidance techniques were observed throughout the facility – educators at the children's level, educators providing appropriate supervision, educators using positive language, educators offering choices, and educators assisting children in decision- making. Outdoors educators are playing an active role in children's activities. Educators have included themselves and their interests in their own documentation.</p>

General Comments

Outdoors the Grades 3-5 school-age group were observed playing in the forest area, lounging in a hammock, playing with natural loose parts and swinging on a wooden tripod. The Educators were participating alongside the children, discussing new project ideas and engaging in conversations about the natural environment.
