Comments:

During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed the following:

- -A can of shaving cream in an unlocked cupboard in one room.
- -A bottle of Enjoy Dairy Again pills in an unlocked cupboard in another room.
- -A can of Luv Fresh Odor Eliminator in an unlocked cabinet in another room.

The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the educators in each room that all toxic products, chemicals, and cleaning supplies must be securely locked and inaccessible to children. All items found unlocked were immediately placed in locked storage.

Deficiency is now compliant

## **General Comments**

The Quality Assurance Monitor conducted an on-site inspection.

The child-to-staff ratio was consistently maintained throughout the visit.

During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following:

- -Compliance with required checks
- -Daily activity schedules
- -Condition and availability of indoor play area materials and equipment

Additionally, the Quality Assrsuance Monitor observed children engaging in free play, arts and crafts, and painting activities indoors.

During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that a shelf was positioned in front of the doorway in the infant room to prevent children from leaving the room. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the educators that placing a shelf in front of the doorway is not an appropriate solution. Instead, the Quality Assurance Monitor suggested either closing the door or using a baby gate. The educators promptly removed the shelf blocking the doorway following the guidance provided.
