| <p>Comments: In one classroom, a cabinet was found unlocked and contained toxic products, such as cans of shaving cream. Toxic products, chemical products, and cleaning supplies must be securely locked and kept inaccessible to children at all times. The administrator immediately locked the cabinet upon notification.</p> <p>In the kitchen, the QAM observed several toxic products, chemical products, and cleaning supplies stored under the sink in an unlocked space. Although children do not have access to the kitchen, either the cabinet itself or the kitchen area must be secured with a lock/key. The administrator informed the QAM that a lock will be installed shortly. To confirm compliance, the administrator may send a picture to the QAM once the lock has been installed.</p> | | | |

| <p>Comments: In one classroom, a cabinet was found unlocked and contained a bottle of children's Tylenol. Facility must have a locked storage space for medication. The administrator immediately locked the cabinet upon notification. Deficiency is now compliant</p> | | | |

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| <p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) conducted an on-site monitoring inspection. During the inspection, the following elements were reviewed and verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Files of new staff members - Storage spaces - Rest area materials - Daily activities - Daily routine - Indoor play area materials and equipment - Diaper changing areas - Washrooms <p>During the visit, children had snack and then transitioned to outdoor play. Due to ongoing playground</p> |
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General Comments

renovations, the preschool groups went on a walk instead of using the outdoor play area. Despite the rainy weather, children were well dressed and ready for the park.

During the inspection, a staff member from another facility under the same operator was present and working as relief staff without her staff file on site, as it remained at the other facility. The administrator immediately made arrangements to have the file delivered to the centre so the QAM could verify its contents. The file was received within minutes of the request

During a visual inspection of each classroom, the QAM noted that all classrooms had learning stories displayed on the walls and utilized webbing as a method of programming and documenting daily activities. Based on these observations, the QAM was able to confirm that educators demonstrate that planning is an ongoing process that involves engaging children and reflecting on their interests, passions, strengths, and abilities.
