General Comments

Upon arrival the children were watching television. Please remember when choosing to use television viewing the following must be applied:

- television viewing must be limited and is not used daily
- they are not used to fill gaps in the day;
- the programs or movies support curriculum, programming and investigating children's areas of interest for example, children want to search out information on a specific area of interest
- programs or movies are appropriate for the ages in your care
- viewing the program or movie is one of several choices of activities for the children
- children are not encouraged to watch television if they would prefer to be involved with other activities
- with preschool children, staff members watch with the children, extend their understanding and promote discussion on the program or movie

The purposely pre- program is not consistently evident. Please utilize a method of programming to keep on file that shows that activities and experiences are based on the children's interests. Examples of this is journaling, webbing or using a calendar to jot down children's interests on. If further assistance is required, you can also reach out to the curriculum team or your quality assurance monitor.

Documentation of this children's learning is evident in the facility. There is parent pictures displayed above the children's cubbies and a collage of pictures with the children in them displayed on the walls. The children's artwork is displayed, and each child has a portfolio with their work in it.

There is many learning centres set up for the children with a variety of materials set up in them. They include music, science, construction, magnetics, art, a cozy corner with books and dramatic play. The children that were attendance seemed to have a large interest in blocks and cars.

All documentation for licensing was easily verified. The operator is filling out required documents properly and is keeping them filed in an organized manner.
