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<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>When licensing staff arrived, children were having snack. Two children sit in highchairs and one at the table. After children finished, the operator washed each of their face and hands with their own face cloth, putting away any leftover snacks. Children then began to move around the space and play. Resources were accessible to the children throughout the space. Resources in baskets on a shelf were labelled with words in english and french and included a photo. There is a kitchen area with kitchen materials and a digital space with a light table, camera and phone. Soft materials are located throughout the room for sitting or snuggles. Labels are located throughout the room to identify areas and resources. Children's names and photos are located throughout the space on the wall, shelves, and a collection of photos of the child at play, with friends, and their interests posted below each peg for belongings. A title of "Our Masterpieces" is posted on the wall with created artwork from each child in frames. Books are located on a low shelf in the reading area accessible to even the youngest child.</p> <p>The operator had new sand toys for children to bring outside with them today. Some purple sand was added to the fresh sand for children to play as well. The operator lifted the cover off for children to play with the new items. Children played throughout the space, swinging, sliding, and running. A play kitchen has a variety of pots, pans, bowls, and utensils allowing children to create their own "meals". Extra resources are located in storage bags and containers and brought out regularly.</p> <p>After an hour of outdoor play, the operator reminded children they were going to go in for naptime. One child finished up cooking in the play kitchen, and the operator allowed them time to transition. Children washed their hands before naptime. The operator sat with children to help with falling asleep. When children get up from their naps, they have lunch. The operator has an earlier naptime to meet the needs to the children and families.</p> <p>Child files and operator's files are organized and complete. All required forms are up to date. The operator is regularly completing PL.</p> <p>This license can be recommended for renewal.</p>
