General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred on April 15, 2026, on this license.

Inspector observed that the children's learning is documented and displayed throughout each of the learning environments. Childcare facility also utilizes Bright Wheel to give parents information regarding their child(ren) as well as pictures of the children's day.

In Room 9A and 9B; the infants have been exploring cardboard boxes. Pictures and learning stories of the children engaged in "forest" play on the floor with artificial grass, wooden tree slices and toy animals was also observed. Learning stories and pictures depict the children exploring colors, using mark making materials, paper, rice and playing with bubbles outside.

Room 10A and 10B: Inspector observed that samples of the children's mark making was displayed within the learning environment. Children have been exploring with paint markers, feather painting. Documentation of the children exploring "a peaceful pond" was also observed. With the children exploring water, floating flowers, toy butterflies, frogs, lily pads, and natural materials. The children have also been exploring sound using musical instruments.

Room 11A: Inspector observed that the children have been exploring letters and numbers, outside play with the music wall, and textures and colors of different yarns in the tuff tray.

Room11B: Documentation depicts the children building towers with blocks, exploring painters' tape, bubbles and finding hidden items in the tuff tray. Sensory exploration with paint feathers, loose parts and playdough was also observed.

Room 12A: The children have been exploring colors using water and loose parts, mixing paints, exploring music and sound with instruments, and exploring patterns and shapes.

Room12B: The children in this room have been exploring construction and building. Documentation of the children building with stones, playdough, wooden blocks, extra-large Lego pieces, building a road outside and

creating a farm were observed.

Inspector observed that all the rooms spent time outside in the outside play area. Diaper changing routines and procedures were also observed being followed.

Inspector observed the educators down at the level of the children when speaking and interacting with them. Educators were also observed sitting with the children during snack and lunch engaging with them, assisting with feeding, and feeding them as required.

Inspector observed educators using positive child guidance techniques when interacting with the children in their care.

Inspector observed that the pack 'n plays that were present in the infant rest areas in room 9B and 10B have been replaced with wooden cribs.

Facility is recommended for license renewal, pending the recommendation from Fire.
