General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred April.30/2025. During the visit, children were observed engaged in indoor and outdoor open-ended free play. Children were engaged in a book about bears with the educator when licensing arrived. The children were acting out the book, making bear noises and telling fun facts they are learning. Educators shared that the children are currently interested in topics such as firetrucks and are in the middle of transitioning the room to reflect the interest. Licensing also observed documentation that reflected open ended play and art involving firetrucks within each of the children's binders. Positive language and gentle reminders were consistently observed in their interactions with the children.

Parents of children attending the center are allowed entry at any time. Outdoor play is incorporated for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time.

Steps and platforms were provided to allow children to access regular-sized toilets and sinks with ease. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed, and a reminder was given that April's fire drill was not completed at time of monitoring, but they had until end of day and will be checked at follow up. The indoor environment is thoughtfully set up but did lack in dramatic play materials. Licensing observed 1 tomato,1 carrot, 1 tong,1 spatula,1ice cream and 1 bun for the kitchen area. Licensing discussed with admin that more dramatic play materials will need to be added. Books reflecting the children's current interests have been carefully selected.

Traffic areas and outdoor walkways are kept clean and free of clutter. Toxic products, such as cleaning supplies, are securely locked and inaccessible to children in the kitchen area. The curriculum is purposefully planned, with daily activities documented in the program. Both individual and group learning opportunities are available, and various forms of literacy are incorporated into the indoor environment.

New staff files were verified. One new staff was missing first aid certificate and signed statement in file, and one was missing job description. Admin will update licensing once completed. Attendance records were verified and complete.
