<p>General Comments</p> <p>The following elements were also observed during the monitoring inspection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The child-to-educator ratio. -Criminal record checks / vulnerable sector checks, valid first aid certificates, valid CPR certificates, as well as job descriptions outlining duties and responsibilities were verified for new staff members. -Posted at the entrance: the daily routine, the menu, fire evacuation procedures, the name of the administrator, the names and phone numbers of the quality-assurance mentor and the inspector, allergies as needed, and any reported illnesses as required. -The facility's daily routine includes outdoor play for at least one hour during every four-hour period. -Positive guidance practices with children. The quality-assurance mentor observed a positive intervention by an educator who repeatedly encouraged a child to get dressed by explaining that there was beautiful snow outside. In another group, an educator encouraged a child to put on their snow pants independently. <p>Although the number of toilets was deemed sufficient at the time of the inspection, it was noted that the bathroom containing two toilets, two sinks, and a diaper-changing area does not have doors or curtains to create private sections. This configuration provides less privacy for children when using the sanitary facilities. It would be advisable to consider modifications that ensure an appropriate level of confidentiality during toilet use and hygiene routines.</p>
