The Operator has never had an illness outbreak however going forward she will submit a Reportable Illness form (Appendix 15) to the Licensing staff in the future.

## **General Comments**

Annual renewal inspection performed. A few compliances addressed during the inspection, and a few more to complete prior to recommending for licensing.

This centre goes above an beyond the Act and Regulations. There is always more than enough staff to cover staff child ratios during breaks and lunches.

Licensing staff reviewed administrative records ... Staff records, staff information was checked, staff and child attendance are tracked daily, infant toddler records completed and signed off, educators are tracking incident reports, potential illness reports when necessary and these are being verified and signed by parent, so they are aware.

Licensing staff observed many children out sick with illness. Educators are documenting this information on the attendance record. The Operator is posting illness notices, so parents are aware. Parents are very supportive of the operator's efforts to keep illness out of the centre and they are keeping children home when they are sick. Educators are also cleaning and sanitizing and following public Health direction.

This centre is clean, organized, programming rooms are inviting, toys and equipment and materials are accessible to children.

Appropriate child guidance observed - Staff were observed assisting children with dressing for outside, sitting with the children during snacks and lunches, involved in their play and positive interaction was observed. 'Can I help you zip it up, that is perfect, thank you'

Children were observed involved in a variety of age-appropriate fun activities. Some children were eating snack upon arrival, swinging, playing house, playing in small groups or on their own. Another group is learning about animals and animal tracks and also putting out apples for the animals in the forest area. They are also making xmas bulbs. In one classroom, the educator has set up a French/English program station and provided lots of reading materials, books, puzzles and games to support language development. They have labelled the centres with both languages. The children have also been contributing to a food donation box for the food bank. Lovely way to involve children in their community.

All children were observed going outdoors today, though with all the rain the outdoor play space is very icy. One group of educators decided to take the younger preschoolers for a walk and another group to walk down to the play area where it was not as icy. Hopefully, we will soon have a bit of snow or warmer weather to melt the ice.
