Comments: While reviewing the educator's files, licensing staff noted that two educator's Social Development checks are dated for more than five years ago. Please ensure the educator's Social Development Checks are updated as soon as possible.			

General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the annual License Renewal Inspection while the children in the three-to-four-year-old classroom were cleaning up in preparation for outdoor play. Before going outside, educators ensured that each child had their water bottle, hat, and sunscreen applied. The children then proceeded to the Forest School playground, where they engaged in a variety of activities. The outdoor environment remained shaded from the sun throughout the morning. Children were observed participating in dramatic play by pretending to operate a restaurant, digging in the sandbox, and riding tricycles. The children in the two/three-year-old classroom went to a local park for outdoor play, while the infants participated in a bear hunt in the forest. The school-aged children played in the open field. The children remained outdoors until lunchtime. Prior to eating, the children washed their hands. Infants were appropriately supervised while eating their lunch. Following lunch, the children in the two/three-year-old classroom were ready for their nap time. Their mats were set up in one end of the classroom. Throughout the license renewal inspection, licensing staff observed educators conducting frequent head counts to ensure the whereabouts and safety of all children. In each classroom, educators had thoughtfully prepared invitations of play to support children's interests and engagement in the indoor learning environments. Examples of these invitations included: -A playdough activity featuring homemade playdough, small rolling pins, cookie cutters of various shapes, and plastic gems.

General Comments

-A sensory and nature-based invitation consisting of dried beans, vases with water and colourful flowers, small metal bowls, plastic insects, greenery, and wooden rings.

-A tuff tray exploration activity containing pieces of sunflower, small tongs, and scissors.

Throughout the inspection, licensing staff observed educators interacting with children using positive child guidance techniques and fostering respectful, supportive relationships.

During the review of staff files, licensing staff noted that several files were missing signed job descriptions and/or signed staff acknowledgement statements.

Please ensure that all educator files contain:

-A signed job description confirming the educator has read and understands their role and responsibilities.

-A signed acknowledgement confirming the educator has read and understands the staff handbook.

-A signed acknowledgement confirming the educator has read and understands the requirements of the Early Childhood Services Act and its associated regulations.
