On the day of the inspection the children engaged in a variety of activities. The educators set up stations for the children to engage with. There was a craft station where the children made their own fish out of construction paper and tape. Along with the craft station there was a game station where the children read a card and then drew what the instructions asked them do draw. The third station was a car station where a group of children had a variety of small cars with a race car mat to run the cars on.

The educators were seen interacting with the children at the child's level.
