The children were still arriving at the licensed facility when licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility. The operator gave licensing staff a tour of the facility upon arrival.

All staff files are very organized and complete with all of the required documents and qualifications and training certificates. The educators and operator meet the qualifications and training ratios as per the Early Childhood Services Act.

While licensing staff was observing all classrooms, the children were playing outdoors in the very lovely environment full of natural materials for the children to engage with and play on. A group of younger children were observed sliding down slides, building ramps, out of spare pieces or wood, for their trucks to slide down and were observed going on a ride in the wooden boat. The activity of sliding trucks down small pieces or wood, for ramps, turned into a much larger scale activity using the slide, that is attached to the climbing structure, for their trucks to slide down. The were observed sharing the ramps and the trucks.

Some of the older children were also outside playing in their outdoor environment that also consists of an abundance of natural play materials. The children were engaging in dramatic play activities. The children enjoyed serving ice-cream, soup and cupcakes to licensing staff and their friends.
