General Comments

On the afternoon of my monitoring visit, children were engaged in a variety of activities indoors. Children were playing in a space themed sensory bin, coloring and cutting paper, playing with a felt board and pieces, and building with block and dominoes. Educators took interest in the children's creations- some children were drawing Luigi masks and others were building with the dominoes and discussing Minecraft. When a child showed interest in the brown woven packing paper that arrived with a parcel for the facility, the operator added it to the children's materials. One child made a cape and the educator helped him tape it together.

Parents are granted entry to the facility at any time and during my visit I took note of this when parents started to arrive for pick-up and came inside.

Snack time is flexible in the earlier part of the afternoon and during my visit, children could choose when they wanted to join the snack table and eat. Other children were able to remain with their activities.

I checked where children hang their belongings and each child has a labelled hook and a space for their items.

Educators did circle time with their groups and spread out throughout the centre. The transition to this part of the day was smooth.

The theme for the week is the solar system and there was evidence of this is many ways- books, learning stories, materials, and discussions during circle time.

After all children had snack, they went outside to the outdoor play area. There are a variety of materials accessible and children enjoyed biking around on the path, building with straws and connectors. There are flowers and plants and places for balancing, climbing and sitting.
