General Comments					

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the license renewal inspection.

The children were engaged in free play activities where the children would freely roam from one activity to another throughout the licensed space until it was time for the children to go outside to play.

Licensing staff observed one group of children engaging in a Halloween activity consisting of a pumpkin, a child sized hammer and golf tees. The children hammered the golf tees into the pumpkin and then removed the golf tees using the other end of the hammer. Another group of children were sitting at a table and eating their snack while a third group of children were engaging in a building activity using a mat on the floor and red coloured building blocks. The children were building a pathway on the mat using the blocks.

The indoor play environment had multiple play centres for the children to explore. The centres that licensing staff noted were as follows- a cozy book centre, a science centre, an art centre, building centre, a practical life centre and a sensorial centre just to name a few.

The children went outdoors to play before coming back inside to have lunch.

Licensing staff heard the educators encouraging the children to problem solve with their peers during play.

Licensing staff had a conversation with the operator of the licensed facility regarding a wooden playhouse, located in the outdoor play environment, that is in need of repairs. The operator relayed to licensing staff that there is a plan for this playhouse to be repaired by the end of this week.

Licensing staff recommends this facility for their renewal of license.
