- -Daily routine into the center includes; Outdoor play time at least once every 4 hour block time, when the weather is permitting. Meal and snacks are served at the recognized hours and a daily period of rest and/or quiet activities to balance their active play.
- -During the visit, a positive approach is observed in the guidance, care, and discipline of children
- -Outdoor play area has at least 10% shade and consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play
- -Material in the outdoor space is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present
- -During the visit, the outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazard
- -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children
