## **General Comments**

- -Mid-Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -During the visit, ratio child-to-staff is maintained and respected in a mixed age group
- -When acetaminophen is administered to a child, the written and signed by the parent consent is filled into the children file.
- -Administration of medication records are evident
- -Medication is locked and stored in the kitchen and inaccessible to children
- -No children are in need of an EPIPEN
- -Prescribed medication is labeled with the doctor's name, instructions, and the time period for use
- -Non-prescribed medication are in the original child safe container with the original label and labeled with the child's name and dosage
- -When acetaminophen is administered to a child, the written and signed by the parent consent is filled into the children file.
- -Staff have started to set up invitation in their rooms for when the children arrive in the morning and throughout the day.
- -Weekly planning of activities is done with the children, planning of the week is on a calendar that is posted on the parent board.
- -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations.
- -In the outdoor play area children have more than one type of surfacing to play and explore, the material offered is varied and in sufficient quantity for children present
- -It was recommended to add sand in the sand boxes, operator is planning on filling the sand boxes in the next couple of days.
- -Material and equipment offered to the children in the indoor play area is safe, clean and in good repair.
- -During the visit staff were setting up the playground.

Observations: Half of the daycare were out on an outing in the neighborhood, the three's were playing in the fenced-in space behind the daycare. When I was leaving, everybody were eating their lunch, and the youngest were setting up for nap.
