General Comments
<p>Visit to home facility to complete annual inspection during COVID-19 period. Ratio was respected during visit.</p> <p>Reviewed COVID-19 guidelines and procedures and provided the operator with a copy of the most recent guidelines. Recommended all plush/clothing items be washed daily or be put away. Reviewed morning screening, daily cleaning schedule, daily logs and physical distancing while using parks.</p> <p>Children's files: One child was missing consent forms, these must be added to the child's file.</p> <p>Ensure that all addresses of those who have permission to pick up child are added to the children's files.</p> <p>Operator must create a list of responsibilities and duties for herself.</p>

## General Comments

The operator had been using a public park as her designated play space, due to there not being enough protective surfacing, the operator has decided to use her yard as the outdoor space. Discussed several ways the curriculum can be brought to her outdoor space. Recommended the operator put a bin outdoors to keep the play materials and equipment.

Recommended operator check with her insurance to make sure she has proper coverage when on outings with children.
