Ratio was respected during visit.</p> <p>Discussion with operator: Step stools be accessible in order to allow more independence for children washing their hands. Daily information sheet and Potential Illness sheet were sent to operator by email during the visit.</p> <p>Observation: Children were playing with play dough and sensory items when I arrived. Children washed their hands and had lunch during visit.</p> <p>Pictures were sent on the same day of the inspection showing that all supplies/accessories were added for diaper changing, cleaning supplies were put into a locked cabinet and that children's spaces were labelled with their names.</p> <p>A follow-up inspection will be completed to verify non-compliances.</p>
