<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection</li> <li>-Ratio was respected during the visit</li> <li>-Posted in the cubbies area when entering the house are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector - Life threatening allergies</li> <li>-When it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease will be posted on the front door</li> <li>-The following administrative records are maintained on site: Financial records, daily attendance of children and staff, menus and any substitution, monthly emergency evacuation fire drills, smoke alarm, smoke detector and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records</li> <li>-Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed</li> <li>-Documentation is now up to date for all children, the operator is planning on organizing everything into portfolio and keep them at the children's level for them to have the opportunity to revisit and explore their learning</li> <li>-Purposefully planned activities are now posted on a white board when entering the playroom</li> <li>-During the visit, it was observed that the operator is engaged with the children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way</li> <li>-Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key in the bathroom and are inaccessible to children</li> </ul> <p>Observations: When arriving at the center children were into free play, they had a snack and then returned to their playing, fishing, drawing, playing hotel.... Literacy has increased into the playroom; all containers are now identified with words and pictures.</p>
