<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Afternoon visit to the learning center for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -All staff have all required documentation into their files and a valid First Aid certificate -Guidance of the children is done in a positive, respectful, and constructive way. -Outdoor space provides children with a safe environment to play, create and explore. -Fenced in space must provides children with 10% of shades -Material and equipment provided for children in the outside space needs to be varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present. It was recommended to have a picnic table so children can eat outside or do craft, had a garden, large trucks for children to play in the sand or with the pea gravel...etc. -Outdoor play area consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play -Cleaning supplies and toxic products are kept under key and out of the children's reach -Daily routine into the center includes; Daily outdoor play time when the weather is permitting. Meal and snacks are served at the recognized hours and a daily rest period that meets the children's needs. -The operator confirm that their numbers will be increasing during the summer so tables, chairs and material will be added <p>Observations: When I got at the center few school age children just arrived from school, they started playing with the parachute. Some started to build with Legos while another group was water painting. The older kids arrived started to play small hockey and joined on building with Legos.</p>
