The operator must ensure the attendance record are taken out of the facility whenever children leave the building.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the signed statement from parents confirming they have read and understood the parent handbook is missing in 1 of the 5 child files audited. During the inspection, the operator obtained a signed statement from parent confirming they have read and understood the parent handbook. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for transporting the child or providing transportation is missing in 1 of the 5 child files audited. During the inspection, the operator obtained written consent from the parent. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for permitting photographs and videos of the child for publication on social media is missing in 1 of the 5 child files audited. During the inspection, the operator obtained written consent from the parent. Deficiency is now compliant.

<p>General Comments</p> <p>During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed the children's arrival, snack time and indoor free play. The inspector also observed the operator playing board games with children,</p> <p>During the inspection the ground was snow covered; therefore, the park assessment will be conducted in the spring with a member of the licensing team. The use of the outdoor play structures is not recommended as the ground is frozen and does not provide protective surfacing.</p> <p>The ratio is respected during the inspection.</p>
