<p>The inspector is on-site to conduct the renewal inspection.</p> <p>During the inspection, the inspector observed the morning outdoor play, lunch period, and rest period.</p> <p>In one classroom, the inspector observe that children are engaged in a reindeer craft activity, which involved coloring, cutting to practice scissor skills, and gluing the pieces onto a page.</p> <p>Meanwhile, in another classroom, a group of children are working together to color a large Christmas-themed coloring page.</p> <p>All classrooms displayed visible crafts created by the children on the walls.</p> <p>After the rest period, the inspector observed a gingerbread cookie decorating activity taking place in all classrooms with the children.</p>

General Comments

A discussion is held with the administrator to clarify that eligible educators must complete the required 10 hours of professional development before the permit expiration date of December 31, 2025.
