Comments: One child profile missing a medical practitioner. All child profiles must have a completed medical practitioner indicated.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (f) daily attendance records of the children on forms provided by the Minister.	24(1)(f)	Jun 03, 2021	
Comments: Infants did not have attendance sheets while outside on playground. Attendance sheets must be kept with the group at all times, including outside on play ground and excursions.  Infant group also had not marked all infants in at time of inspection. All children must be marked in on the attendance sheets as they arrive to ensure a correct count of children in case of emergency.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Jun 11, 2021	
Comments: In the upstairs classroom there are a sofa and a foldable cushion bed which are ripped and are no longer non-absorbant. These items must be covered with washable covers or be removed.			
36(3) The rest area of a full-time early learning and childcare centre and an early learning and childcare home shall be equipped with the following: (a) a crib or portable playpen for each child under 15 months of age in accordance with the Cribs, Cradles and Bassinets Regulations and the Playpens Regulations under the Canada Consumer Product Safety Act (Canada).	36(3)(a)	Jun 03, 2021	
Comments: One infant crib was found to be a drop-side crib. According to these standards as of December 29, 2016, the sale, importation, manufacture or advertisement of traditional drop-side cribs is prohibited. This crib must be replaced.			
36(6) A cot, a nap mat or the mattress of a crib or portable playpen shall be washable and non-absorbent or covered with a non-absorbent layer.	36(6)	Jun 11, 2021	
Comments: Two infant mattresses were found to be fabric. If using fabric mattresses they must be covered in a non-absorbant, non-slip cover. These must be covered or replaced.

Comments: Infant beds are not labelled. Each infant bed must be labelled.			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>All Covid-19 protocols were followed during inspection.</p> <p>Positive interactions between children and educators were observed during Inspection.</p> <p>Inspector notes that a discussion was had with the Administrator regarding items used to secure small structure in infant space, as well as surfacing required for this item and recommends to check the manufacturers manual to ensure compliance.</p> <p>Inspector recommends checking the Cribs, Cradles and Bassinets Regulations Canada Consumer Product Safety Act which is available online, and ensure all cribs meet standards.</p>
