Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the reason for the children's absence was not indicated on the daily attendance records in one of the class. The administrator must ensure that the reason for absence is recorded on the attendance record.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (b) permitting, in the case of illness or soiled clothing, the child to shower or bathe or showering or bathing the child.	27(b)	Aug 19, 2022	Sep 14, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the signed consent for bathing or showering in the event of illness or soiled clothing was in all of the 10 files verified. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that a storage area was removed from one of the rooms giving 3.25m ² of indoor play space for each child. Deficiency is now compliant			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (b) arranged on low, open shelves and accessible to the children receiving services at the licensed facility,	32(1)(b)	Aug 26, 2022	Sep 14, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that art materials were accessible on low, open shelves. Deficiency is now compliant			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Sep 16, 2022	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection the inspector observed that two out of ten bottles were not labelled with the child's name. The administrator must ensure that all water bottles are labelled with the child's name.			
43 An operator of a licensed facility shall not permit hot beverages in areas that are occupied by the children receiving services at the licensed facility, including the outdoor play area.	43	Sep 14, 2022	Sep 14, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed a hot beverage in a classroom located next to the kitchen. For the safety of the children, hot beverages are not permitted in areas that are occupied by the children. Deficiency is now compliant
