Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate is missing in 1 of the 17 employee files. The operator must ensure that a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate is maintained in the educator's file.			
21 The daily activities of a licensed facility shall be purposely planned in advance and documented and shall respond to the capabilities, needs and interests of each child.	21	May 17, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that planning is not up to date in 2 of the 5 classrooms. Operator must demonstrate that planning is a process that involves engaging the children and reflecting on the children's interests, passions, strengths and abilities.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (iv) the name, address and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the child's parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency if the parent or guardian cannot be reached,	24(1)(b)(iv)	Apr 07, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that an emergency contact is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that the name, address and telephone number of at least two people authorized by the child's parent to pick up the child and contact in case of emergency if the parents cannot be reached is noted in all children's files.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (v) the child's health history and a copy of the record of immunizations or a copy of an exemption.	24(1)(b)(v)	Apr 07, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that a child's health and immunization record or a copy of an exemption is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that a copy of the child's health and immunization record or a copy of an exemption is placed in the child's file.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the staff signed statement regarding obligations under the Act and licensing regulation is missing in 2 or 17 staff files verified. The operator must ensure that a signed copy of the statement regarding obligations under the Act and licensing regulation is maintained in the educator's file.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (c) staff member records that include (vii) a copy of a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate for each administrator and educator.	24(1)(c)(vii)	May 17, 2023	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate is missing in 1 of the 17 employee files. The operator must ensure that a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate is maintained in the educator's file.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (k) emergency evacuation and fire drill records.	24(1)(k)	May 17, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that fire drill records are missing for the month of January and March. The operator must ensure that emergency evacuation and fire drills are conducted monthly.			
25 An operator of a licensed facility shall post in a clearly visible and prominent place on the premises: (a) the daily routine.	25(a)	Apr 06, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the daily routine is not posted in 1 of the 5 classrooms. The daily routine must be posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (b) permitting, in the case of illness or soiled clothing, the child to shower or bathe or showering or bathing the child.	27(b)	Apr 07, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that consent for bathing or showering in the event of illness or soiled clothing is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that consent for bathing or showering in the event of illness or soiled clothing is provided by the parents.			
28(2) An operator of a licensed facility shall carry out emergency evacuation and fire drills monthly.	28(2)	May 17, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills were not completed in January and March. The operator must ensure that emergency evacuations and fire drills are conducted monthly.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Apr 12, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed a hole in a wall in two of the classrooms. The holes are currently covered with clear packing tape. The operator must repair and paint the drywall.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Apr 04, 2023	Apr 04, 2023
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed cleaning products in unlocked cabinets located inside 2 different bathrooms. The inspector observed a can of paint on a desk in the office. The inspector also observed a bottle of Off on a shelf in one of the classrooms. During the inspection, the administrator placed the paint in a locked cabinet and locked the other cabinets with a key. The administrator also placed the off in a locked cabinet. Deficiency is now compliant.			
47(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall refuse admission to a child if satisfactory proof of the immunizations required by the Public Health Act or the regulations under that Act is not provided.	47(1)	Apr 07, 2023	

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Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that proof of immunizations or an exemption prior to the child's entry is missing in 1 of the 10 child files verified. The operator must ensure that proof of immunizations or an exemption is placed in the child's file prior to the child's entry.
