When children are in the outdoor play area or on outings, staff members must have copies of the attendance records with them as well as emergency contact information. An educator immediately went inside to grab the attendance record sheet. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed 2 bottles of shaving cream, 1 bottle of rubbing alcohol and 1 bottle of scent spray. All toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The products were immediately locked. Deficiency is now compliant

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection.

During the visit, the following elements were verified:

- Ratio and maximum number of children
- If all the required documents were posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility
- Outdoor play area
- Storage space

Ratio was respected during the visit. Parents and staff members are well informed of important information regarding the operation of the facility. The facility provides outdoor play area materials and equipment that are varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services.

During the visit, the QAM observed children playing indoors and outdoors.

The QAM had a discussion with the staff in charge regarding an ECE certificate. Only a letter saying that the educator completed the ECE program was in the file. The official ECE certificate must be inserted in the file
