Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor noted that the shelf in the infant room remained turned toward the wall, limiting children's access to the materials. The educator promptly repositioned the shelf to make the materials accessible to the children. A further discussion was held with the administrator regarding the importance of maintaining accessible learning environments for children. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the pink chair in the infant room had been replaced and that the couch in the upstairs classroom had been repaired. Deficiency is now compliant			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Jul 20, 2026	Aug 20, 2026
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the infant educator confirmed that the infants who had previously required bottles or soothers no longer required them and were no longer using them in the classroom. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the educators and the administrator that when an infant requires a bottle, it must be clearly labeled and stored in the refrigerator with its cover. Similarly, if an infant requires a soother, it must be labeled and stored in an individual container designated for that child. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor conducted a follow-up monitoring inspection and was present during the morning snack. All deficiencies are now compliant. Child-to-staff ratios were maintained and respected throughout the visit.
