General Comments

Upon my arrival parent(s) continued to arrive within an hour of the program being opened. Educators in the room advised licensing staff that arrival and departure times fluctuate between 8:30 am and 11:30 am. Educators greeted both parent(s) and children and the interactions appeared to be positive.

The educators attention were directly on the children at all times. Licensing staff observed infants being rocked and bottle fed and when they became upset, the educators would comfort them or take them on little walks within the building in a stroller to distract and calm them.

In the older room, the educators were engaged with the children at their levels. Educators were observed playing on the floor with the children, helping them dress-up in dramatic play and setting up materials that the children were interested in.

Child guidance was gentle and respectful. Licensing staff heard an educator asking for permission to help a child when they saw that needed assistance. The children were not rushed during snack time and were given permission to get their snacks as they wanted to.

There are many materials available and presented to the children at their level. This includes but is not limited to a kitchen, a puppet theatre, easels, books, cars, construction materials, and a variety of art materials. Invitations for play were also set up for the children at the table.

Attendance records were being kept for both daily and extended hours. The extended hours demonstrated that there are never 12 children in care at once. This program operates tentatively every second Saturday for deployment.

All documentation was easily verified for licensing purposes. Files are organized and complete. I can now recommend facility for licensing.
