**General Comments**

Follow-Up Visit performed to check on non-compliances.

Since my last visit the floor was replaced throughout the room and in the two washrooms and painting was done. The room looked great and staff have worked hard to organize materials and set up different play areas around the room. There are some new wooden pieces in the space and they add to the coziness of the room. The educator informed me that the pieces will be getting a varnish coat on them to seal the wood.

I observed children finishing up lunch and choosing activities to play before they left for their field trip. Children enjoyed helping sweep and wipe tables. Other children had fun dressing up in costumes and drawing.

The educator had strong child guidance techniques and the children felt comfortable coming to her. I observed her comforting a child and reminding him that it is okay to experience different emotions and cry. She also provided consistent routines and expectations. Children finished lunch, pushed in their chairs, put lunch bags away and zipped up bookbags and the transitions were very smooth. She offered various suggestions of activities and played along with them. She gave praise and positive reinforcements to the children as well. The room was operating smoothly and the children were happy and engaged.
