General Comments

When licensing staff arrived, children were still arriving for the day. Infants entering their room were provided some cuddles and time to transition to the facility. The room is large and provides space to run and move. There was a discussion with the educators about creating documentation of the children's learning and representing it in the room. For example, the educators had intentionally created sensory mats that the children enjoyed in their bare feet and the educators were using words to model the sensory elements. Documentation of this important invitation can include educator's reasoning for their choice, connections to the curriculum and why this is important, children's experiences such as words expressed and reactions to different materials, as well as photos of the invitation for children to revisit and sharing with parents.

There is a family photo wall posted in each room. The photos in the infant room are located behind plexi-glass to allow children to point out their families. Pictures of food are also scattered around family photos providing an opportunity for educators to share food related vocabulary and talk about favorite items.

There are learning stories, photos, and children's artifacts posted in the hallway and portfolios for children in rooms. Our community photos are posted in rooms providing a connection to community and allows children to begin recognizing environmental print.

The children all went outside this morning. The infants went for a short walk across the parking lot after playing with bubbles and sidewalk chalk. The older children were on the playground playing with vehicles, shovels, and large tubes. The tires were stacked in one corner from the winter and the children were challenging themselves in risky play climbing and jumping on them. The facility is transitioning from the winter so a reminder to bring out kitchen items, more resources, and writing materials for children.

Staff to child ratio was met at all times and snack was as posted.
