The inspector and Quality Assurance Monitor will be conducting a visit together to ensure that the new plan is respected.

General Comments

Name of operator

The inspector is on site with the Quality Assurance Monitor for a follow-up inspection. During the visit, the inspector observed the preschool children doing a Christmas light craft.

The operator must ensure that children have a designated outdoor play area that is compliant to the Early Childhood Services Act and regulation. The administrator presented her plan to the inspectors. Administrator discussed that the new plan would accommodate 100 children. Regarding the article 31

(5): The operator of a full-time or part-time early learning childcare center shall include a shaded area of at least 0.45m2 for each child that can be accommodated in the outdoor play area as provided under subparagraph 4(1) (g)(ii), the operator must have 45m2 for shade.

The ratio was respected during the inspection.
