Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the administrator has documented the PL hours. However, educators have not documented their PL hours but are currently working on them.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Oct 03, 2024	
Comments: The inspector did not observe the children outside because it was raining. It was confirmed that the children will no longer use the entrance of the Dome during outdoor play. While on site, the inspector and Quality Assurance Monitor discussed with the administrator a plan for the outdoor play area. A new plan was discussed, and this will need to be put in action starting now. The inspector and Quality Assurance Monitor will be conducting a visit together to ensure that the new plan is respected.			
33(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide outdoor play area materials and equipment that are varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	33(1)	Oct 03, 2024	
Comments: The inspector did not observe the children outside because it was raining. Therefore, was not able to observe sufficient toys. With the discussion of the new plan, toys will be available to children. The inspector and Quality Assurance Monitor will be conducting a visit together to ensure that the new plan is respected.			

General Comments
<p>The inspector is on site with the Quality Assurance Monitor for a follow-up inspection. During the visit, the inspector observed the preschool children doing a Christmas light craft.</p> <p>The operator must ensure that children have a designated outdoor play area that is compliant to the Early Childhood Services Act and regulation. The administrator presented her plan to the inspectors. Administrator discussed that the new plan would accommodate 100 children. Regarding the article 31</p> <p>(5): The operator of a full-time or part-time early learning childcare center shall include a shaded area of at least 0.45m² for each child that can be accommodated in the outdoor play area as provided under subparagraph 4(1)(g)(ii), the operator must have 45m² for shade.</p> <p>The ratio was respected during the inspection.</p>
