22 The daily routine of a licensed facility shall include (a) outdoor play for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of children receiving services are in attendance except in the following circumstances: (i) the wind chill is below -20 °C; (ii) the temperature is below -20 °C; or (iii) the temperature is 33 °C with humidity or above.	22(a)	May 08, 2026	
Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) was present at the facility for several hours. Upon arrival, preschool children had just completed naptime and were engaged in free indoor play. At the time the Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) left the facility, at approximately 4:40 p.m, preschool children had not participated in outdoor play. Licensing requirements state that outdoor play must be provided for a minimum of one hour within each four hour block of time.

Comments: During a review of new staff files, the Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) identified that two staff members' records were missing a description of their duties. All staff records must include a description of duties and responsibilities.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (c) staff member records that include (iv) a signed declaration confirming that the staff member has read and understood his or her obligations under the Act and this Regulation.	24(1)(c)(iv)	May 13, 2026	
Comments: During a review of new staff files, the Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) identified that three staff members' records were missing a signed declaration. All staff records must include a signed statement acknowledging staff members' obligations under the Act and the Licensing Regulation

<p>Comments: During the inspection, the administrator was unable to provide the Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) with a monthly review and maintenance plan for all stationary equipment in the outdoor play area. The administrator advised that a plan had been started; however, it may have been misplaced. A monthly review and maintenance plan must be completed for all stationary equipment and must include the review and repair dates, the action required and taken, and the name of the staff member who completed the review</p>			
<p>38(1) The children receiving services at a licensed facility shall have access to washrooms that include the following: (a) if one to nine preschool children or school-age children are receiving the services, one toilet and one sink; (b) if ten to 24 preschool children or school-age children are receiving the services, two toilets and two sinks; (c) if 25 to 49 preschool children or school-age children are receiving the services, three toilets and three sinks; and (d) if 50 or more preschool children or school-age children are receiving the services, four toilets and four sinks.</p>	38(1)	May 15, 2026	
<p>Comments: At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) noted that one bathroom was not available for use. The administrator indicated that the stall door was broken and requires replacement. Centres must maintain the required number of functioning and accessible toilets and sinks. For a centre licensed for 60 children, a minimum of four toilets must be available.</p>			
<p>39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;</p>	39(2)(a)	May 07, 2026	May 07, 2026
<p>Comments: While verifying the washrooms, the Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) observed a container of Lysol wipes stored in a bathroom cabinet. Toxic products, chemical products, and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The administrator immediately relocated the cleaning supply to a locked storage area. Deficiency is now compliant</p>

The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) was on site to conduct a monitoring inspection. During the visit, the following elements were reviewed and verified:

During the inspection, preschool children transitioned from naptime to indoor free play. School-aged children engaged in indoor play and later transitioned to outdoor play.
