General Comments

Upon Licensing staff arrival, the children were playing on the side hill of the outdoor play space. The children were observed using a large climbing rope that was secured to a tree, running along a path, sliding down the hill on their bottoms and using a yellow slide. The children were observed respecting the set outdoor play area boundaries and were enjoying adventurous child led play.

While outdoors, the children were observed playing baseball, using trucks in the sandbox and water play. The highlight of the morning for the children was planting potatoes in the garden. The Operator explained to the children how to plant them. The Operator was observed pointing out the rainbow from the mist from the hose created when watering what they had planted. Positive child guidance and problem-solving opportunities were observed during a little disagreement between friends while taking turns with the hose and comforting cuddles were given after a tiny tumble. The Operator was very caring and engaged with the children offering encouraging words such as "Good listening ears" and "You are such a great farmer!".

Later in the morning, the children and Operator went indoors to wash hands and to take a cool down break before a second little snack. The indoor space was clean and play material such as wooden blocks, a wooden tic-tac-toe game, art easel with paint, play costumes, loose play pieces, a carpenter station, a chalk board, trains, and books were all in good condition and organized. Twinkle lights were hanging from the ceiling and children's artwork was on display throughout the space.

During inspection, child and Operator files were verified. The parent board was visible, and children's belongings were organized on hooks with their names in the main entry. Monthly fire drills are being recorded and daily attendance is being recorded
