General Comments

Preschool children were playing with blocks while they were waiting for everyone to have their turn in the washroom when I arrived for today's visit. Once everyone had their turn to use the washroom, everyone got ready to go play outside. Educators were observed encouraging the children to try and get dressed independently before they ask for help, they were also observed providing lots of praise and encouragement to the children at this time.

The preschool's outside fenced in play space offers a variety of different material for the children to play with. Some materials that the children were observed playing with were colored tires, coloring large rocks, play structure with slide, playhouse, mud kitchen, pots, pans and shovels, etc. There is a treed area in the outside play space that appears to provide natural shade for the children.

When the school age children go off the bus from school (early dismissal day today), they went directly inside to wash their hands. Once they finished washing their hands, they hung up their stuff, got their lunch boxes, had a quick circle to check in and see what they had planned for today and then proceeded to eat. Once lunch was over, they were able to play at stations until it was time to go outside. Educators informed them that there were two activities that they could partake in when outside if they wanted to. One was a nature themed scavenger hunt, and the other was nature-based craft.

The facility's indoor environments offer a very bright and caring atmosphere for children to grow, learn and thrive in. Both the preschool and school age classrooms have an abundance of learning materials that meet the interests of the children. The indoor environments are also set up in a way that promotes independence by having all play material on low shelves so that the children can pick and choose what they wish to play with.
