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General Comments

Upon licensing staff's arrival, the mixed-age preschool group was transitioning indoors for snack. Educators supported the children in changing into indoor shoes, washing their hands, and sitting down for snack. The transition was observed to be smooth. During snack, educators assisted children with opening food items as needed while encouraging independence through encouragement. Educators engaged the group in a conversation about their planned visit to the splash pad later that day. Children discussed riding the Go-Go Bus and shared what they were looking forward to during the outing.

Following snack, children washed their hands and transitioned back outdoors. They were observed engaging in a variety of activities, including playing in the sandbox, using the outdoor play kitchen and accessories, building with blocks, and climbing on the play structure. One educator facilitated a beach ball drawing activity. As the UV index increased, educators applied sunscreen to the children in preparation for continued outdoor play. Throughout the outdoor play period, educators were observed using positive guidance strategies, including encouraging children to express their feelings and communicate with one another, saying things like "Good job using your words!" to children.

The group later transitioned indoors for lunch. Rest mats were prepared for children who wished to rest following lunch, as the group was scheduled to travel to the downtown splash pad in the afternoon using the Go-Go Bus.

Monthly fire drills are conducted. Documentation was also observed with each child having an individual binder containing their creations completed throughout the year. Staff-to-child ratios and attendance records were verified and found to be in compliance.

A recommendation was provided to the site coordinator to incorporate regular water bottle breaks during outdoor play on hot days to encourage children to remain hydrated.

Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.
