General Comments

Operator promotes an environment that encourages positive and independent behavior by involving the children by giving them responsibility and letting them help themselves, all while providing adequate supervision. Observed operator using positive language with children and respecting their feelings.

Outside play space consists of natural play material which the operator has made herself, much of it with the help of the children. Children loved that they were able to pick out their own book for the operator to read to them from their "outdoor library" and also loved that the operator read them their choice of book in the boat!

Please be sure to turn over or rake protective surfacing to be sure proper depths are maintained, it is recommended that this be done weekly. The proper depths for mulch and pea gravel is 30cm (12 inches).

General Comments

A reminder that the use of a non-contact thermometer is not permitted for children under 12 years of age.
