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General Comments

Licensing staff arrived in the morning to do a renewal inspection. The children begin the day outside in their fenced in play area and on Tuesdays they assemble in the gym for Tuesday Chapel with the Kindergarten to Grade 5 students. Everyone sings Bible songs and Bible stories are told and this gives the children a chance to meet their peers before they switch over to school. Their classroom is lovely, bright and clean and well organized and the children's learning stories and artworks are posted. They had a brief story time where the educator read "How to Catch a Star by Oliver Jeffers to the children however some of the children were restless so they moved to different areas of the room for free play. There were a variety of learning invitations and play areas set up such as dramatic play, a cozy corner, building area, and tabletop activities such as lego, and a large art table to name a few.

Staff are kind and patient with the children, and all transitions were peaceful and calm. They use Class Dojo to send pictures, learning stories and to communicate with the parents during the day. They shared a learning story about sticks and their relationship to words and mark making where the educator made connections to the curriculum as well as documenting the child's learning.

Next the children went outside to their fenced in play area for outside play. This area has a variety of surfaces and lots of shade, with trees, grass, bark, rocks, pea gravel, a small hill, a teepee, a pergola with grape vines, shade sails, a raised platform with a picnic table and a large sandbox with new sand under another pergola. There were many different activities going on, from colouring at the picnic table to driving the wagon around the trail.

The parent board was complete and up to date. Fire drills were posted, incident reports completed, and attendance sheets and the first aid kits were complete and taken outside with the children. All staff files and 10 child files were verified during my visit, and all required documents were present.

I recommend that this license be renewed.
