General Comments								
Licensing Staff arrived at the Facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, Licensing Staff reviewed staff and child files. The files obtained all required documents and were easily accessed. Today was the first day of the Afterschool Program. The Educators were outside on the playground and met the children as classes were dismissed. Educators were observed signing the children in as they arrive.  The Educators were heard asking the children how their first day went and were well spread out on the playground to ensure all areas were supervised. The children were seen laughing and smiling as they played on the play structure, the slides, and the swing set.  Inside, the classroom was well organized and inviting. The room is bright and offers a variety of materials such as books, wooden blocks, dolls, board games, plastic animals, and a play kitchen area. At one of the tables, a bracelet making station was set up for the children. All bins in the classroom were clean and labelled. One section of the room is dedicated to artwork and offers a variety of crafting supplies. Paint sticks, glue, scissors, pipe cleaners, beads, fabric, and paper on a shelf at their level and available for the children to use.
