After the activity, the children lined up to wash their hands for lunch.

The indoor space was clean and well organized with various resources available. The educators were engaged with the children. Each child has a designated space for their personal belongings.

All staff files were reviewed and found to be complete. All required documents were posted visibly on a board by the main entrance and a nut allergy sign was posted. 15 child files were reviewed. Four files did not have a family doctor. Licensing staff suggested identifying a nearby clinic or hospital in case of emergency.
