General Comments

Upon arrival, the children were transitioning inside and getting ready for snacks. An educator started a game of "Simon Says" while they waited for the other children. After snack, the children started an activity called "Camper's Choice". Three activities were taking place in the facility and the children rotated. The first group were in the gym playing with a parachute. They played "Cat and Mouse". The educators were engaged and playing with the children. The educators ensured each child had the opportunity to play each role. The children had a water break and returned to playing another game with the parachute and dodgeballs.

The second group were in a room doing "Perler Beads". The children had blank canvases where they could create the design of their choice. The educators were observed to be helping the children and sitting with them. One educator was ironing the beads in another room so the children could bring their craft home.

The third group were in another room doing "Shrinky Dinks" the children were at tables creating their craft while the educators observed. An educator was providing the option to hole punch if they wanted to make key chains. One educator was observed sitting on the couch and reading a book with a child. After the activity, the children lined up to wash their hands for lunch.

The indoor space was clean and well organized with various resources available. The educators were engaged with the children. Each child has a designated space for their personal belongings.

All staff files were reviewed and found to be complete. All required documents were posted visibly on a board by the main entrance and a nut allergy sign was posted. 15 child files were reviewed. Four files did not have a family doctor. Licensing staff suggested identifying a nearby clinic or hospital in case of emergency.
