| Licensing Staff arrived at the Facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children were sitting at tables in small groups eating morning snack. The room was clean, bright and welcoming. As the children finished eating, hands were washed, and the children freely explored the classroom. As the children were finishing morning snack, one Educator set up a scrape painting activity. The Educator set out several containers of paint, paper, paint smocks for the children to wear and cards for the children to scrape the paint with. Several children showed an interest in this activity. The Educator stayed close to the group, offering assistance when needed. Throughout the morning the children engaged in a variety of activities such as playing dress up, building car ramps with wooden blocks and creating a large tower out of magnetic tiles. The flow of morning was smooth, the children appeared familiar with the routine and classroom expectations. A gentle reminder was given before the children worked together to clean up the classroom and prepare for outdoor play time. Child profiles were reviewed during today's Monitoring Inspection. Files were tidy and contained all required documents. Current learning stories, pictures of the children and artwork were observed in the classroom and out by the cubby area. Only positive child guidance was observed. The Educators were engaged with the children in the morning activities and were attentive to their needs. | | | | | |
