Comments: When QA monitor arrived at the facility, she observed that a notice to inform parents of a gastrointestinal outbreak was posted at the entry. The administrator informs QA monitor that she was not aware she had to inform Public Health. When an outbreak of gastrointestinal illness with vomiting and/or diarrhea has been identified, operator must notify Public Health. Staff should be knowledgeable to this following document: Guidelines for the Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases in Early Learning and Childcare (ELC) Facilities

General Comments
Follow-up monitoring inspection conducted. QA monitor was on site to observe child guidance. QA monitor entered new staff member's information into the system. She was able to observe lunch, and the transition to nap time. Positive interactions between educators and children were observed. QA monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding the importance to complete an incident report in the event of a reportable incident such as an illness outbreak. The administrator was not aware that an incident report had to be completed for the gastrointestinal outbreak that was happening the day of the inspection. An incident report must be completed, and a copy must be sent to QA monitor within 24 hours.
