## **General Comments**

The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site to conduct a follow-up inspection.

During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor engaged in a discussion with the administrator regarding an incident where preschool-aged children and infants were mixed together in the outdoor play area. The administrator stated that they were unaware that mixing these age groups is not permitted. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the administrator that it is their responsibility to ensure compliance with all applicable regulations.

The administrator indicated they would review the Child Care Act and Regulations to ensure proper understanding moving forward. The Quality Assurance Monitor also reminded the administrator that they have previously signed a statement in their staff file confirming that they have read and understood the Act and Regulations.
