Comments: In the outdoor play area QAM observed, children playing on a dome to climb onto that is surrounded by protective surfacing, but the protective surfacing is not of appropriate depth. Pea gravel should be turned over or raked weekly to ensure proper depths are maintained. The recommended minimum depth of material (compacted) is 30 cm. The climbing dome must not be used by children until the depth of pea gravel is appropriate. Operator immediately asked the educators to not permit climbing on the dome and added a parachute, so kids won't be able to climb onto. QAM advised operator that pea gravel must be added for children to be able to climb onto the dome or for the dome to be removed. Deficiency is now compliant.
